B: Thanks. I want to learn Japanese from students, too.

A: You can speak Japanese very well. How long have you lived in Japan?

A: Could you tell me how to get to the nearest station?

B: Sure. Go straight and turn left at the second corner.

A: Is it far from here?

A: Excuse me, is this the tourist information center for foreigners?

B: Yes, it is. May I help you?

A: Yes, please. I am afraid that I left my phone on the train.

[問題 B]

ユカはオーストラリアの語学学校短期留学にやってきた日本人の高校生です。ホームステイをするジョーンズさんの家です。最初の夕食の後に、ユカとジョーンズさんが話をしています。この会話を聞き、英文の内容が合っていれば○、間違っていれば×を解答欄に書きなさい。会話は2度放送されます。

- Yuka: Thank you for the delicious dinner, Ms. Jones.
- Ms. Jones: My pleasure. I'm glad you liked it, Yuka. Everyone likes pizza, right?
- Yuka: I was surprised to see egg on the pizza.
- Ms. Jones: Oh, really? This is a classic Australian pizza with tomato, cheese, ham, bacon, and eggs. Everyone here calls it an "Aussie Pizza."
- Yuka: I see. Well, it was really good. Thanks again. Can I help wash the dishes?
- Ms. Jones: No, that's OK. You just arrived at our home, and you must be tired, so just relax. I'll put the dishes in the dishwasher.
- Yuka: Thank you. Could I take a shower?
- Ms. Jones: Sure.
- Yuka: I have one more question before that.
- Ms. Jones: What is it?
- Yuka: Tomorrow is my first day at the language school nearby. On my schedule, it says the first period starts at 9 a.m. I will have to take a placement test then. What is the placement test?
- Ms. Jones: That's correct. A placement test is needed to check your English level, and it is used to decide which class is good for you. After the 1<sup>st</sup> period, there is a school tour and an orientation. Before the third period, you have a tea break. After you finish the third and fourth-period classes, there is a longer lunch break. Usually, students bring their own morning tea and lunch to school, but you can also buy food at the school canteen.
- Yuka: Canteen?
- Ms. Jones: I think you call it a "cafeteria."
- Yuka: I see.
- Ms. Jones: We'll give you your morning tea and lunch pack before you leave the house in the morning. If you want to eat more, you can always buy something extra in the canteen.
- Yuka: Got it. What time should I leave the house to be on time for my first-period class?
- Ms. Jones: It's just a ten-minute walk, so if you leave here at 8:40, you'll be fine.
- Yuka: OK, thanks. I'll take my quick shower now, then.
- Ms. Jones: Sounds good, Yuka. I'll see you later.
